Format: 4 rounds Swiss – Game/60 + 5 second delay (USCF and KCA-rated); Sections: Scholastic, Adult

Entry Fee: All Players Pay On-Site Day of the Tournament

Only Cash and checks will be accepted. Checks should be made out to the Anatoly Karpov Chess School. Refer to the table for entry fee rates. All advanced entries must be in by e-mail by December 18 by 9:00PM. USCF and KCA membership REQUIRED. These can be purchased for an additional fee on-site.

Scholastic EF: \$10 if pre-registered; \$15 On-Site

Adult EF: \$15 if pre-registered; \$20 On-Site

Awards: Scholastic division(K-12): Medals for 1st-15th place

Adult Division: \$250 Prize fund (based on at least 20 entries) 1st place: \$100; 2nd:\$75; 3rd:\$50; 4th:\$25

Tournament Directors: Gabe Purdy (Chief TD)

Equipment: Sets and clocks will be provided

Concessions: The Chess School is ideally located in downtown Lindsborg, with many local restaurants within a block.

Other: Players are expected to know the rules in U.S. Chess Federation's Official Rules of Chess - 6th edition and any updated rule changes since the 6th edition. Please bring Clocks/Boards. Rule 32C2 is not valid for this tournament. No fee for entry or parking. There is a time delay of 5 seconds. Byes are offered for all rounds except the last round, if requested prior before the start of the tournament. ^Rounds 2-4 will run back-to-back i.e. the round may start earlier. 30 minutes for lunch.
