## **2015 Renaissance Festival Report**



Our Renaissance Festival chess booth has been in business for 22 years now. The festival itself runs for seven weekends. It always starts Labor Day weekend. Most often it stops Columbus Day weekend, but this year since Labor Day was late, it stopped the weekend after Columbus Day weekend. Weather was ideal this year with only the first weekend being excessively hot and rain of significance only on Labor Day.

Our booth is our major fund raiser for the Kansas Chess Association. Membership fees are the only other source of funds. Because of the Renaissance Festival Booth we haven't had to raise KCA membership fees for over 10 years. The money raised helps support chess tourneys, such as the Kansas Open, and support our scholastic candidates to the US Open national tourney.

This year we (KCA) raised \$1389. This is after our fixed expenses of liability insurance (\$190), a Bonner Spring tax (\$55), and booth maintenance in the form of extra mulch and plants are subtracted. This total is after the Renaissance Festival gets its 15% of receipts excluding donations.


